Operating Policy and Procedure

**OP 40.03:** Sexual Misconduct

**DATE**: August 14, 2020

**PURPOSE:** Texas Tech University (TTU) is committed to providing and strengthening an

educational, working, and living environment where students, faculty, staff, and visitors are free from sex discrimination of any kind. Therefore, TTU prohibits discrimination based on sex and other types of sexual misconduct, including but not limited to sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, and stalking. The purpose of this Operating Policy/Procedure (OP) is to (1) state TTU's requirements for reporting incidents of sexual misconduct; (2) state TTU's policy on sexual misconduct; (3) implement electronic reporting protocols for such incidents; (4) develop a comprehensive prevention and outreach program; (5) establish penalties for noncompliance with this OP; and (6) provide amnesty or immunities to students

and employees who report incidents of sexual misconduct.

**REVIEW:** This OP will be reviewed in November of odd-numbered years by the TTU Title IX

Coordinator, Dean of Students, and Assistant Vice President for Human Resources, in consultation with the System Offices of Equal Opportunity and General Counsel,

with substantive revisions forwarded to the Associate Vice President for

Administration and Chief of Staff to the President. Any substantive changes to this

policy must be approved by the Board of Regents.

### POLICY/PROCEDURE

- 1. Discrimination based on sex and other types of sexual misconduct (including the reporting and prevention of, and the grievance process and remedies for sexual misconduct) in the TTU community is governed by Texas Tech University <a href="System Regulation 07.06">System Regulation 07.06</a>, which includes two distinct policies and procedures based on applicable federal and state law:
  - a. System Regulation 07.06.A Title IX Sexual Misconduct, and
  - b. System Regulation 07.06.B Non-Title IX Sexual Misconduct.

The Sexual Misconduct Policy Applicability <u>Flowchart</u>, attached to each policy, summarizes these policies' applicability and their respective procedures.
