			Verify page has a unique title
			Verify all information for timeliness and accuracy
			Check for spelling and grammatical errors and ensure proper use of punctuation
			Verify all graphics are saved at the web optimized resolution of 72dpi, sized for their intended display location and in the appropriate format for their content (JPG, GIF, PNG)
Security/ Legal Issues			
			Register web site with the TTU IT Division
			Verify content is free from illegal activities such as distributing copyrighted music, movies, or other material, lobbying for a specific politician/political party, or hosting a commercial site selling items for profit.
			Verify pages adhere to minimum standards set forth in the TTU IT security policies
