On Thursday, a Clery notice was sent out to the campus community concerning information surrounding a reported sexual assault. Today, we are writing to ensure the campus community is aware of a range of support services and resources Texas Tech University has in place to assist anyone who may have been affected by this situation. Care and support of our campus community is a primary function of these TTU departments and we stand ready to assist any community member in need. Any member of our community who may need support may contact the Office of the Dean of Students to request assistance. Support and resources include, but are not limited to, a referral to the Student Counseling Center, our prevention and education department (Risk Intervention and Safety Education or RISE), and Student Health Services. Student Rights and Resolution and the Title IX offices offer additional support and can assist community members who need to report an act of sexual misconduct. Employees may contact Equal Employment Opportunity and Employee Assistance Program for similar services.
