RE: Annual Security Reports

The Annual Security Reports for Texas Tech University, TTU Costa Rica, TTU Center in Sevilla and all regional sites are now available. This report is required by The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, the Clery Act. The reports contain policy statements, reporting options, emergency response information and crime and fire statistics for the university.

The Annual Security Report includes site specific policy statements that address the university's policies, procedures and programs concerning safety and security. The report also includes three years of statistics for Clery specific crimes that were reported to have occurred on campus, within off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by Texas Tech University, and on public property within or immediately adjacent to campus. In addition, the reports for the Texas Tech University campus in Lubbock and regional site in Junction include the Fire Safety Report which contains information about fire systems, fire safety, and three years of statistics regarding fires that occurred in on-campus student housing facilities.
