Dear Texas Tech community,

I want to begin by assuring you that due to the immediate response by law enforcement, there was **no threat to the campus community** following an overnight incident involving officers from the Texas Tech Police Department.

At approximately 12:45 a.m., Texas Tech Police officers were checking on a suspicious vehicle just off the Marsha Sharp Freeway frontage road near the north side of Jones AT&T Stadium. During that interaction, the individual in the vehicle opened fire on the officers. The suspect was shot and pronounced deceased at the scene.

Two of our officers sustained non-life-threatening injuries and were transported to University Medical Center, where they are receiving care. Please keep them and their families in your thoughts and prayers. We are deeply grateful for their service and courage.

The safety of our students, faculty and staff remains our highest priority, and I am grateful for the quick response of our officers and first responders. They, like each of you, are part of a strong and resilient community, and that strength is especially evident in moments like this.
