COVID-19 DASHBOARD UPDATE

On Friday, May 14, Texas Tech will suspend the reporting of new COVID-19 cases through the [university dashboard](#). We first began our campus reporting dashboard in August of 2020, and we believe this tool has helped keep our campus well-informed regarding the active spread of COVID-19 amongst students, faculty, and staff.

Thanks to your due diligence and the rollout of the vaccines, we have reported just 247 cases since the beginning of the spring semester. Over the last several weeks, our numbers have dropped considerably, and as of today we only have six active cases.

The City of Lubbock has transitioned from daily reporting to weekly reporting and if you would like to have an understanding of the current spread of COVID-19 in the city, I would direct you to the [health department website](#).
