VACCINES NOW AVAILABLE

Dear Texas Tech Community,

Beginning today, all students, faculty, and staff over the age of 18 can begin scheduling appointments to receive the COVID-19 vaccine through the City of Lubbock Health Department. The health department is opening appointments to all adults well ahead of the state's March 29 deadline to provide availability to all Texans.

On Monday, March 29, all Texans will be eligible to receive the vaccine and that means that additional vaccine clinics across the city of Lubbock will now be able to serve our university community.

The university will no longer maintain its vaccination waitlist and encourages individuals to schedule their own appointments.

The City of Lubbock is currently operating its vaccination clinic at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center and you can make an appointment beginning today through [Select-A-Seat](#). On Monday, vaccinations may be available locally through Walmart, Sam's Club, H-E-B, United Supermarkets, United Market Street, United Amigos, CVS, and Walgreens. Additional locations may become available soon, including possible on-campus pop-up clinics hosted by area pharmacies.

As future vaccine opportunities become available, we will provide additional communications.
